The Negro W. E. B. Du Bois 2014-11-24 Africa is at once the most romantic and the most tragic of continents. So begins *The Negro*, the first comprehensive history of African and African-derived people, from their early cultures through the period of the slave trade and into the twentieth century. On black contributions to the Civil War and to the emancipation of slaves, historians have yet to acknowledge all that Du Bois delineated. In his discussion of Reconstruction, Du Bois preempts much later historiography. His identification of segregation as an issue of class rather than race is almost forty years ahead of C. Vann Woodward's similar thesis. As to the matter of race, Du Bois is clear that the concept is a social construct having no foundation in biology. Intellectually and historically prescient, Du Bois assumed globalization as a matter of course, so that his definition of the color line in *The Negro* links all colonized peoples, not just people of African descent. With the resolution of the Cold War and the ascendancy of the global market, Du Bois's sweeping vision of Africans and the diaspora seems more relevant now than at

any time in the past hundred years.
