*Lack of Critical Thinking Ability Among the Primary and High School Students of Bangladesh and Its Effects on Their Tertiary Level Education and Employment Prospects* Thauhida Rupa 2017-01-23 Master's Thesis from the year 2013 in the subject Pedagogy - Common Didactics, Educational Objectives, Methods, language: English, abstract: The topic of concern of the research is the critical thinking ability of the primary and high school students of Bangladesh and its effects on their tertiary level education. In the research, the critical thinking ability of these levels of students was found to be deficient to an extent. The research has found that the recently introduced creative method has proved to be more favorable for developing the critical thinking ability of the students than the previous methods, though the creative method is struggling for effective implementation for various reasons.
